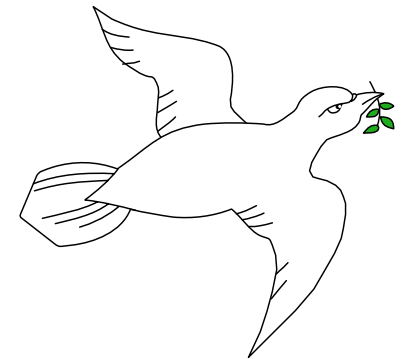

IF YOU ARE CONVICTED

Conviction of the offense with which you have been charged carries these possible consequences:

- ◆ **A maximum of 6 months in jail**
- ◆ **A maximum fine of \$2,500 plus surcharge**
- ◆ **A maximum of three years probation**

THE ALTERNATIVE

You may be one of those individuals eligible for this diversion program offered by the City Prosecutor's office.

Assuming eligibility requirements are met, you may choose to participate in a minimum twelve (12) session educational/therapeutic experience.

THE BENEFIT TO YOU...

- ◆ **No jail time**
- ◆ **No fine**
- ◆ **No conviction for this charge**

PROGRAM OUTLINE & FEE STRUCTURE

Should you be allowed to participate in this program, you will be required to call and schedule an initial screening interview within **48 hours** of your court appearance. Your appropriateness for the program will be determined at this initial screening. If you are eligible, you will then be assigned to a minimum twelve (12) session educational/therapeutic experience. A condition of program eligibility is that you must take responsibility for the offense.

The fee for the initial screening is **\$60.00** and **must be paid in cash, money order, VISA or Mastercard** at the time of the screening. If you schedule an appointment and fail to keep that appointment, you will be charged a **\$15.00 "No Show" fee**. The fee for the twelve (12) **program sessions is \$240.00** and may be paid in payments (\$20) each time you attend a session.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

You will attend an Intake Interview and a minimum of twelve (12) Group Therapy Sessions.

You may be required to attend additional therapy sessions or no cost Self-Help groups.

You must complete the program within **100** days. If you do not enroll in the program in sufficient time to complete before your scheduled court date, you will have to return to court to face possible revocation of the Anger Management (P.E.A.C.E.) program option.

COURSE CURRICULUM

- ◆ Training in skills to identify, understand, and control anger, aggression, and violence.
- ◆ Information on the effects and control of stress.
- ◆ Psychological profiles and personality evaluation.
- ◆ Ways to improve the effectiveness of your communication.
- ◆ Education in the role of alcohol and drug use in problems with anger.
- ◆ Referral to community resources to provide additional assistance in working with various problems.
