# Arizona (or out-of-state) MVD Driver's License Reinstatement

If your Arizona driver's license has been revoked because of an alcohol related

offense, there is a process in place that will assist you in getting that important privilege restored. We can help with that process. It's as simple as 1,2,3! Follow the easy directions and you will be on your way to regaining the freedom of operating a motor vehicle legally in Arizona and beyond.

1. Obtain MVD Paperwork.
2. Schedule *Justice Services'* Screening.
3. Re-Apply to MVD for License.\*

\*License reinstatement at discretion of MVD

## Step 1—MVD Paperwork

- A. Go to one of the Arizona MVD offices during normal business hours.
- B. Obtain a complete 59-Month Motor Vehicle Record. This is a 59-month record of your specific driving history.
- C. Have Form "A" notarized with your signature at the MVD or by any notary.

- D. Have Form "B" signed by the Clerk of the court where your last DUI was heard.

## Step 2— Justice Services' Office

- A. Schedule an appointment with the nearest *Justice Services'* office convenient for you.  
**Phone: (480) 949-8871**

- B. When you come to your appointment, bring:
  1. Documentation of all treatment programs attended.
  2. A listing of ALL DUIs received.
  3. Record of blood alcohol content (BAC) for each DUI received (including other states).
  4. The Arizona MVD Packet with form A & B completed.
  5. All signatures and dates must be within 30-days of appointment with *Justice Services.*

## Step 2— Continued...

6. The 59-Month Motor Vehicle Record.
7. \$175 in cash, money order, VISA, or Master Card. No personal checks accepted.

*At Justice Services you will have a private appointment with a licensed, professional counselor who will assist you in completing an assessment form that will be professionally evaluated. Once this assessment has been completed you may proceed to step 3, below.*

## Step 3—Arizona MVD Office

- A. The completed forms in the MVD packet will be mailed by Justice Services' to the Arizona MVD office for processing.
- B. We mail a copy to you of the completed revocation packet.

- D. MVD will send you a letter to the mailing address printed on the revocation packet regarding the outcome.

**MVD makes the determination for reinstatement.**
