## IF YOU ARE CONVICTED

Conviction of the offense with which you have been charged carries these possible consequences:

- ◆ **A maximum of 6 months in jail**
- ◆ **A maximum fine of \$2,500 plus surcharge**
- ◆ **A maximum of three years probation**

## THE ALTERNATIVE

You may be one of those individuals eligible for the Shoplifting Diversion Program offered by the Scottsdale City Prosecutor's office.

Assuming eligibility requirements are met, you may choose to participate in a single six (6) hour educational/therapeutic class.

## THE BENEFIT TO YOU...

- ◆ **No jail time or jail costs**
- ◆ **No fine**
- ◆ **No conviction for this charge**

## PROGRAM OUTLINE & FEE STRUCTURE

Should you be allowed to participate in this program, you will be required to call and schedule an initial screening interview within **48 hours** of your court appearance. Your appropriateness for the program will be determined at this initial screening. A condition of program eligibility is that you must take responsibility for the offense.

The fee for the initial screening is **\$60.00** and **must be paid in cash, money order, VISA or Mastercard** at the time of the screening. If you schedule an appointment and fail to keep that appointment, you will be charged a **\$15.00 "No Show" fee** for a rescheduled appointment. The fee for the **six-hour class is \$150** that must be paid before you can actually reserve a seat in the class.

## PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

You will attend an Intake Interview and then attend a single six-hour shoplifting class.

**You may be required to attend additional therapy sessions or no cost Self-Help groups.**

You must complete the program within **100** days. If you do not enroll in the program in sufficient time to complete before your scheduled court date, you will have to return to court to face possible revocation of this option.

## COURSE CURRICULUM

- ◆ Broadens the understanding of Arizona shoplifting/theft laws.
- ◆ Teaches acceptance of responsibility for our actions.
- ◆ Teaches values clarification.
- ◆ Includes life skills training.
- ◆ Explains the role of alcohol and drug use in theft behavior.
- ◆ Emphasizes and teaches stress management skills.
- ◆ Teaches about cognitive distortions and decision-making skills.
